



National court cases on freedom of movement

[Luxembourg, 16 June 2008]: Caselex starts rolling out cases on freedom of movement law which serves at the heart of European Union (EU) law. In parallel it launches Latvian Supreme Court cases, bringing its total case coverage to nine areas of law and 23 countries.

It does also hold provisions for free movement of workers and freedom of establishment.
